COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is designed to provide nurse with knowledge in assessing the newborn in the 1st few days of life. Course content includes Gestational Age Assessment, Newborn Physical Assessment including both normal and abnormal variations, Transition to Extrauterine Life, Care During Transition, Abnormal Transition, and Some Selected Problems seen in the Term Newborn as well as the Effect of Maternal Medications on the Newborn (very brief). The content is presented through lecture and case studies.

This program was designed for Labor and Delivery nurses, Postpartum nurses Mother/Infant nurses and Newborn nursery nurses, who care for the healthy newborns in Level I facilities.
