

# PATIENT VISITATION POLICY

Ohio State University Medical Center encourages and facilitates visitation in a manner that promotes healing, balances the needs of all patients and visitors, and creates a safe and secure environment. Thank you for being part of the healthcare team and respecting these guidelines for overnight visitation.

## **Overnight Visitation Guidelines**

- All overnight visitors must wear an identification badge between 10 p.m.–5 a.m.
  - Please wear the badge above your waist throughout your visit.
  - The badge will expire in 24 hours. Please return to the Rhodes Hall Information desk and obtain a new badge for each overnight visit.
- The needs of our patients are the primary factors in deciding whether to allow overnight visitation.
- To provide a healing atmosphere that allows for patients rest, visitation is limited to one visitor per patient from 10 p.m. - 5 a.m.
- There are numerous waiting areas for you to stay during your visit. Please notify the nursing staff where you will be waiting. The staff can call you during the night if the patient's condition changes or if the patient is asking for you.
- Our first priority is to care for our patients. You may be asked to wait in an alternate location based on the needs of both patients in the room.
- To assure the safety of children, please have a non-patient adult supervise children under the age of 12 at all times.
- For the safety of our patients, cell phones and other radio-transmitting devices may not be used in patient care areas. There are clearly Identified, designated areas where cell phones may be used.
- Help prevent the spread of Infection by washing your hands often and covering your mouth when coughing or sneezing.

## 患者探望政策

### PATIENT VISITATION POLICY (Chinese)

俄亥俄州立大学医疗中心鼓励和支持探望，但同时考虑促进康复、平衡患者与探望者需要，以及创建一个安全环境。感谢您成为健康护理团队的一员并遵守夜间探望准则。

#### 夜间探望准则

- 所有夜间探望者在晚上 10 点至凌晨 5 点之间必须佩戴身份牌。
  - 在您探望期间，请始终在手腕上佩戴此牌。
  - 此牌在 24 小时内有效。每次夜间探望前，请到 Rhodes 大楼服务台获得新的身份牌。
- 患者的需要是决定是否允许夜间探望的主要因素。
- 为了提供利于患者休息的康复氛围，从晚上 10 点到凌晨 5 点每名患者只允许一名探望者。
- 在您探望期间，有多个等待区可供停留。请通知护士您将在哪里等候。在夜间，如果患者病状变化或者要求见您，护士可以给您打电话。
- 我们的首要工作是照顾患者。根据病房内两位患者的需要，可能要求您在另一个地点等候。
- 为了确保儿童的安全，12 岁以下的儿童应始终由一位非患者成年人监护。
- 为了患者的安全，在患者护理区不允许使用手机和其他无线电发射设备。在有清晰标记的指定区域中可以使用手机。
- 应经常洗手并在咳嗽和打喷嚏时捂住口鼻，以防止病菌传播。
